
Hello!

# Meet John


John grew up in a small town in West Tennessee and has always loved the outdoors – camping, biking, hiking, and swimming. As an adult he loves to travel and experience new cultures.


Flint has cousins that have been adopted, and his grandfather explained, "You can't tell the difference- the love is the same."

Flint was the baby of his family with two sisters: Tammy and Sherry. Flint's mother has ten grandchildren who call her Granna.




Flint's late father, Poppa, left a legacy of giving, hard work and family first.

Each year, we try to do something to give back to others. This year, the grandkids made comfort kits for the homeless.




